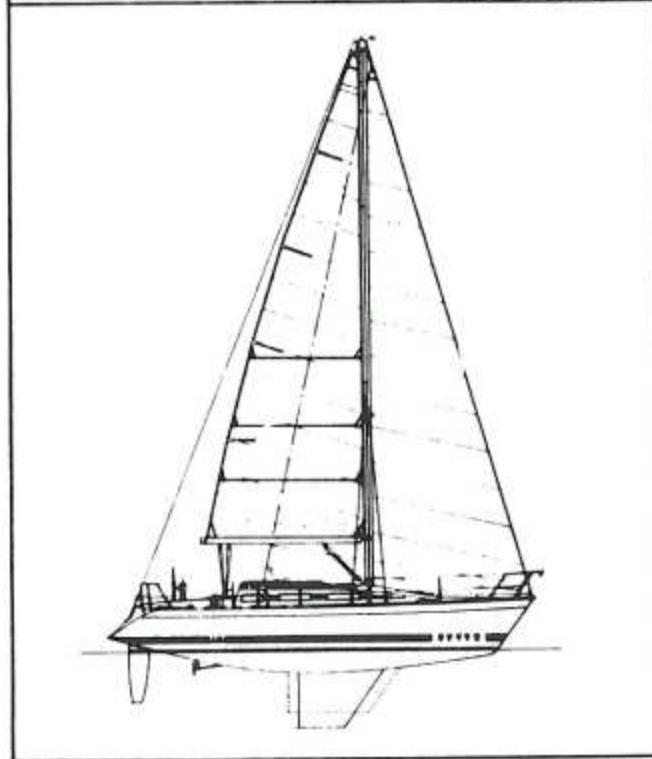
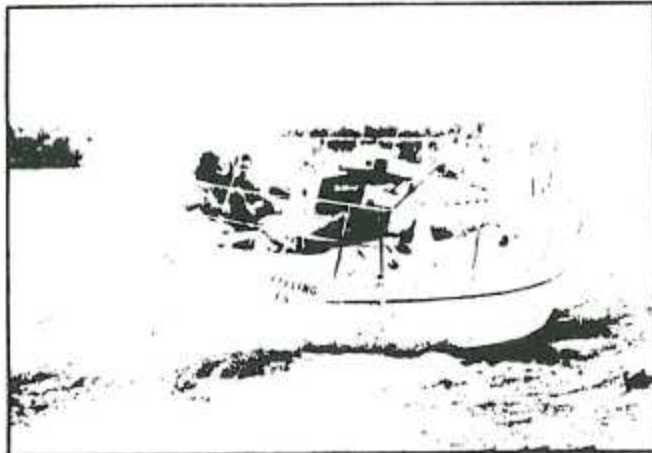
This boat is a slightly bigger sister of the Elite 32. The designer, Philippe Harle, updated his original design by making a longer transom, incorporating a swim platform, and modifying the aft underbody and spade rudder.

This performance cruiser offers very spacious accommodations, with a large saloon, folding table, and L-shaped settee, which converts to a double berth. There is plenty of storage space behind both settee berths and in outboard shelves.

The well-designed galley has a three-burner stainless steel stove/oven, double stainless steel sinks with hot and cold pressurized water, a large ice box, three storage drawers with ventilated bins, and outboard lockers. Under the counter is a dish-draining compartment.

The two cabins have double berths, hanging lockers, and ample storage space for comfortable living aboard. The head/shower aft, with storage under the sink and vanity, has pressurized hot and cold water. The wet hanging locker is also situated in the head.

The interior is finished in light varnished elm wood, and attractive fabrics are used to create a bright atmosphere. The boat is well ventilated with three opening hatches, and the aft cabin also has an

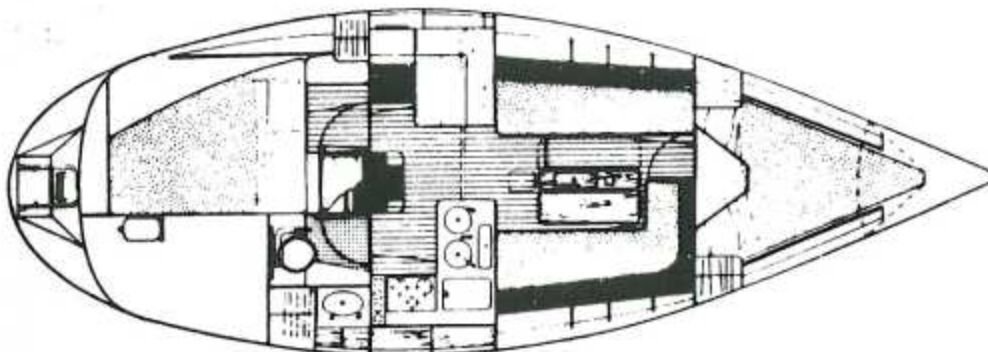


opening port.

Her tall, stiff rig and well-planned running rigging make her a joy to sail, as she combines pure speed with quick, responsive handling. As all the running rigging leads aft to the cockpit, this boat is easily handled by two people and would make an excellent family cruiser/club racer.
